K & V Homes is a big winner at HomeShowExpo 2006

fter all the nails had been pounded and all the furniture was arranged, K & V Homes of Urbandale walked away with top honors at HomeShowExpo 2006, held in June in the Bent Creek neighborhood in Urbandale.

The "Best of Show" award went to K & V for Home

No. 6, a 5,000-square-foot house featuring walnut floors, custom-forged iron railings and hand-applied textured walls.

Wolf Construction of West Des Moines won the "People's Choice" award for Home No. 8.

"It was nice to get 'Best of Show.' Yes, it was," says Colin King, who owns K & V Homes with partner Dean Vogel.

K & V has participated in the HomeShowExpo for three years and has won other awards in the past, but this was its first "Best of Show" designation. Its also took first place for "Best Landscaping" and "Best Craftsmanship," second place for "Best Curb Appeal" and third place for "Best Overall Kitchen," "Best Master Bedroom," "Best Second Bedroom" and "Best Entertainment Room."
